<u>Desert agave</u>	<u>Agave deserti</u>	LV: basal, linear, whole, thorns, apex-acuminate, >12"; FL: 6 parts, yellow, head flat-topped, spring/summer; ST: >6'; EC: desert, edible ST
<u>Century plant</u>	<u>Agave parryi</u>	LV: basal, lanceolate, fleshy, thorns, >12"; FL: 6 parts, yellow; EC: desert;/grassland, edible ST ☐
<u>Schott agave</u>	<u>Agave schottii</u>	LV: basal, lanceolate, whole, fibers, apex acuminate, >6"; FL: 6 parts, yellow, >1", spring/summer/fall; FR: capsule, <1"; ST: >6'
<u>Wild hyacinth</u> (Atlantic camas, eastern camas)	<u>Camassia scilloides</u>	LV: basal; FL: 6 parts, blue; EC: roadside
<u>Sotol</u> (desert spoon)	<u>Dasyilirion wheeleri</u>	LV: basal, lanceolate, thorns, fleshy, >12"; FL: 6 parts, white/green/brown, spring/summer; FR: samara; ST: >12'; EC: desert/grassland, edible ST
<u>Beargrass</u>	<u>Nolina microcarpa</u>	LV: basal, linear, whole, serrate, apex acuminate, >12"; FL: 6 parts, green/brown, raceme, spring; ST: shrub; EC: grassland/fields
<u>Narrow-leaved yucca</u>	<u>Yucca angustissima</u>	LV: lanceolate/linear; FL: white, raceme, pendant long stalk; FR: capsule, seed black
<u>Soaptree yucca</u>	<u>Yucca elata</u>	LV: lanceolate, spiny-toothed, apex acuminate, >12"; FL: 6 parts, white; ST: tree, >6'; EC: desert, edible FL FR
<u>Spanish bayonet</u> (Adam's needle and thread, Adam's needle, common yucca, bear-grass, needle-palm, silk-grass, spoon-leaf yucca)	<u>Yucca filamentosa</u>	LV: basal; EC: grassland/fields/roadside
<u>Harriman's yucca</u> (Spanish bayonet)	<u>Yucca harrimaniae</u>	LV: basal, lanceolate, fibrous, apex acuminate, >12"
