<u>Inkberry</u> (bitter gallberry)	<u>Ilex glabra</u>	LV: alternate, evergreen, whole, elliptical/oblanceolate, entire/serrated, apex acute, base acute, >1", coriaceous, glandular; FL: 7 or more parts, white, raceme, solitary, axillary, <1", spring;/summer; FR: drupe, black, <1"; ST: shrub, >1', erect, smooth, gray, rhizome; EC: coastal/forest
<u>Winterberry</u> (black alder)	<u>Ilex verticillata</u>	LV: alternate, whole, oblong/obovate, serrate, apex acute/mucronate, base acute, >1", glabrous, coriaceous; FL: 7 or more parts, white, sessile along stem, clustered, <1", summer; FR: drupe, red, summer/fall/winter; ST: shrub, >6', smooth, gray; EC: wetland/salt marsh
<u>Yaupon</u>	<u>Ilex vomitoria</u>	LV: alternate, evergreen, whole, coriaceous; FL: white, <1"; FR: drupe, red; EC: southeastUS
<u>Mountain holly</u> (catberry)	<u>Nemopanthus mucronatus</u> (<u>Ilex mucronata</u>)	LV: alternate; whorled, petiole purple, whole, oblong/elliptical, entire, apex mucronate, base acute, >1", glabrous, coriaceous; FL: 4/5 parts, white, raceme, <1", spring; FR: drupe, red, summer; ST: >6', buds-mucronate/purple; EC: wetland ☐
