<u>Bristly sarsaparilla</u>	<u>Aralia hispida</u>	LV: sheath, pinnate, serrate; FL: petals imbricate, white, umbel, <1"; FR: berry, black; ST: >1', grooved, prickly; EC: forest
<u>Wild sarsaparilla (false sarsaparilla, shot bush, small spikenard, wild liquorice, rabbit root)</u>	<u>Aralia nudicaulis</u>	LV: whorled, ovate, 5-pinnate, serrate, apex acute, >6"; FL: petals imbricate/reflexed, white, umbel, <1", spr/sum, stamen longer than petals/white; FR: berry, purple/black; ST: herb/shrub, <1'; EC: forest, edible FR
<u>Spikenard</u>	<u>Aralia racemosa</u>	LV: sheath, pinnate, serrate, base cordate; FL: petals imbricate, umbel, <1"; FR: berry, purple; ST: >1'; EC: forest
<u>Water pennywort (American marshpennywort, navelwort)</u>	<u>Hydrocotyle americana</u>	EC: wetland
<u>Hydrocotyle (manyflower marshpennywort, dollarweed, water pennywort, acariçoba)</u>	<u>Hydrocotyle umbellata</u>	EC: wetland
