<u>Pretty face</u> (golden star)	<u>Triteleia ixioides</u>	FL: 6 parts, yellow w/median stripe
[Subfamily]	<u>Convallarioideae</u>	
<u>Wild lily-of-the-valley</u> (Canada mayflower, false lily-of-the-valley, two-leaved Solomon's seal)	<u>Maianthemum canadense</u>	LV: parallel venation; FL: 4 petals, white, terminal cylindrical cluster; EC: forest
<u>False solomon's-seal</u> (treacleberry, feathery false lily of the valley, Solomon's plume, false spikenard)	<u>Maianthemum racemosa</u>	LV: sessile, oblong, parallel venation; FL: 6 parts, white, panicle, terminal; FR: berry, brown; EC: edible-ST
<u>Starry false solomon's-seal</u> (star-flowered solomon's seal)	<u>Maianthemum stellata</u>	LV: alternate, sessile, whole, lanceolate, entire, apex acute, base obtuse, >1", parallel venation; FL: 6 parts, white, raceme, terminal, <1", spring/summer; FR: berry, green/black w/stripes; ST: herb, erect, >1', zigzag; EC: coastal/forest
<u>Solomon's-seal</u> (smooth Solomon's-seal, great Solomon's-seal)	<u>Polygonatum biflorum</u>	LV: sessile, oblong, parallel venation; FL: 6 parts, yellow, axillary, drooping; ST: >1'; EC: forest, edible-ST, root
